

In the Name of the Republic of Texas.

Let all to whom these presents shall come know, that I, Andrew Jackson
President of the Republic aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by
previous Ray. Law, and in accordance with the Statutes of said Republic in such case
made and provided, do by these presents Grant to Ericurus Ray, his heirs
or assigns forever, Six hundred and forty Acres of Land, situated and
described as follows, to wit: In Robertson County, on Cedar Bluff Creek a branch
of the Trinity River. Beginning at the South corner of a survey of Six hun-
dred and forty Acres made for Thomas Martin, a State farm which a
Post Oak 12 in. dia. *br.* N. 22° W. 90° E. and a Post Oak 15 in. dia. *br.* S. 28° W. 114° W.
thence North 20° West, with the S. W. line of said survey, as 270 ac. across Cedar
Bluff creek, at 1900 or the West corner, a State in prairie, thence S. 60° W. 1900
acres to a stake, from which a Post Oak 15 in. dia. *br.* N. 33° E. S. W. and a Post
Oak 14 in. dia. *br.* N. 77° E. 20° E. thence South 30° East at 1350 ac. across Cedar
and Cedar Bluff creek, at 1900 ac. set a Post. from which a Post Oak 12 in. dia. *br.* N. 12°
Ray and his W. 500 ac. and a Post Oak, 24 in. dia. *br.* N. 6° W. 60° E. thence North 60° East
thence or by nineteen hundred acres to the place of beginning. Thence by following
from all the right and title in and to said land heretofore held and possessed
by the Government of said Republic, and by which issued the said Patent
for the same.

In testimony whereof, I have caused the Great Seal of the Republic to
be affixed as well as the Seal of the General Land Office.

Done at the City of Austin on the Thirty first day of
December, one thousand eight hundred and forty five
and the year of the Independence of said Republic the tenth.
