Robertson County Texas Nov. 15th 1821

Survey for Greivous Bay of six hundred and forty
acres of Land situated on Cedar Bluff Creek, a Branch
of the Trinity river; being the quantity to which he is entitled
by virtue of Head right Certificate No. 316 issued the 9th day
of Decr. 1839 by the Board of Land Com. for the County of
Red river.

Beginning at the south corner of six hundred
and forty acres surveyed for Thomas Martin - a stake from
which a Post Oak 12 inches in diam. bears N 22 W 70 varas and
a Post Oak 15 inches in diam. bears N 28 W 114 varas.

Thence N 30 W with the S.W. line of said survey - at 270
varas crosses Cedar Bluff Creek - 1900 varas to its west corner stake
on a prairie -

Thence S 60 W 1900 varas to a stake from which
a Post Oak 15 inches in diam. bears N 33 E 8 varas and a Post Oak
14 inches in diam. bears N 77 E 20 varas.

Thence S 30 E at 1250 varas crosses Cedar Bluff Creek
at 1900 varas set Post from which a Post Oak 19 inches in diam.
bears N 12 W 5 varas and a Post Oak 24 inches in diam. bears
N 6 W 6 varas.

Thence N 60 E 1900 varas to the place of beginning.
